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## Where to Eat Biscuits and Gravy



From September 6<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup>, get ready to loosen up that belt and indulge in a hearty serving of some of the south's best comfort food right here in sunny San Diego for National Biscuits and Gravy Week!

Live the southern life, seaside at [Backyard Kitchen & Tap](#) in Pacific Beach. Order the Biscuit n' Gravy, complete with homemade

cheddar scallion biscuits, lusciously covered in creamy sausage gravy with any-styled eggs. Seriously hungry? Step it up and order the Chicken, Biscuit n' Gravy with added free-range chicken cooked southern-style.

Biscuits and gravy tastes even better on a rooftop deck overlooking the blue Pacific Ocean, which is only one of the many highlights of [Pacific Beach AleHouse](#). Here, the classic southern dish is made with a crumbly cheddar onion biscuit and creamy sausage gravy, complete with eggs and your choice of bacon or sausage. Feeling stuffed? After your meal, take a relaxing stroll along the beach located a short minute's walk away.

According to [Tavern](#) in Pacific Beach, just "because last night was a doozie," doesn't mean brunch should be. Before your day at the beach, treat yourself to their Biscuits and Gravy spread which includes three house-baked biscuits lathered in their house-sausage gravy.

Steps away from the sand you'll find [The Duck Dive](#), an upbeat restaurant that serves a spin on the traditional biscuits and gravy. You won't be disappointed with their Biscuit and Gravy Sliders made with scrambled eggs and sausage in between two house-made biscuits, covered by homemade sausage gravy!

Craving a little kick to your biscuits and gravy? [Brazen BBQ](#) in Hillcrest has you covered. Their warm, fluffy biscuits are lathered in their Cajun Hot Link Gravy, which includes

chunks of their signature hot links. Mouth-watering, indeed!

Savory and sweet is a flavor combination that has yet to fail, and is exactly what you'll find at [Uptown Tavern](#) located in Hillcrest. Their Biscuit and Gravy plate is perfect for those post-night-out brunches. This hair-of-the-dog dish consists of three large buttery house biscuits smothered in Uptown Tavern's distinctive chicken-apple-sausage gravy.

If you've just finished a very strenuous activity (getting out of bed counts!), head over to Brian's 24 in Gaslamp to replenish your energy. At [Brian's 24](#), they certainly don't joke around with the meaning of the word "plus." Their Biscuits and Gravy Plus includes a well-deserved serving of any-styled eggs, warm biscuits smothered in sausage gravy, bacon, and all-you-can-eat (you read that correctly) home fries. Bring on the elastic waistband pants!

While exploring San Diego's historic Gaslamp quarter, stop by [Union Kitchen & Tap](#) for some warm southern fare and hospitality. Their Biscuits and Gravy dish, composed of their house-made sausage gravy, pairs perfectly with their bottomless mimosas.

[True North Tavern](#) is basically the king of all biscuits in North Park, proven by their selection of "bomb-ass" biscuits. If you want to keep it simple, go for the Chicken Cheddar Biscuit complete with fried chicken, cheddar and garlic mayo. If you're feeling a little adventurous, the Firebird Biscuit has zesty jolts of Sriracha aioli and roasted Serrano peppers. Or, order their Smashbrown Biscuit that includes a crisp tater tot patty, strips of juicy bacon and bacon mayo.

On the weekends between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m., locals delight in the brunches served at the relaxed, urban [West Coast Tavern](#) located in North Park. This eatery serves cheesy cheddar biscuits with house gravy and sausage, giving it the southerner seal of approval. If you're looking for more protein, try the Fried Chicken Biscuit Sandwich topped with bacon and gravy. Bonus tip: if you're thirsty, West Coast is also known for their giant Mules and Bloody Mary bar.

Now you don't have to travel to the south to get a taste of that home-cooked goodness. Embrace your country roots and enjoy a good ol' plate of Biscuits and Gravy for National Biscuits and Gravy week!
